Our initiatives include

- Supporting the teaching of reading through additional teacher aide time to enable grouping of students according to need
- Providing additional teacher aide time to support individual needs in Years 5, 3, 2 and 4
- Providing additional teacher aide time to support special need students
- Implementing early intervention strategies: Gross motor program for Prep students – 2 times a week, additional teacher aide time to support and continue speech programs, professional development on the Early Start program, additional teacher aide time to support individuals in Years 1/2
- Improving student engagement through the cultural program Kapahaka
- Improving student engagement through the improvement of the classroom learning environment to promote learning and engagement



Reading Groups (teacher aide time)	\$63,000
Learning Support – Additional teacher aide time - 2 hours by 3 days by 3 aides (18 hours per week)	\$25,200
General Aide Support – Years 1/2 – 1 aides by 4 hours by 4 days (16 hours per week)	\$22,400
Special Education Support - (additional - 20 hours per week)	\$28,000
Early Intervention Strategies - Bee Fit (before school fitness + Prep, gross motor program)	\$10,000
Student engagement - Cultural - Kapahaka	\$6,000
Speech support – (1 aide by 5 hours per week)	\$7,000
Curriculum Support	\$10,000
Professional Development	\$9,400
